- I enjoyed the Flipgrid discussions best and would maybe suggest those as the discussion board options and then have the written assignments.
- I would suggest making sure all dates are correct before publishing the course. I know Dr. Hicks created the shell and Dr. Parker was teaching this course for (maybe?) the first time, and she did change most of the dates, but that caused some confusion. I also would have liked to know more about the final project before beginning our assignments, because it would've helped to know that parts of those smaller assignments would be components of our final project. I would make sure that is explicitly clear from the get-go.
- I really enjoyed this class. This was a lot of information presented in a short time frame, along with the class assignments, I felt that it was a little overwhelming. I also thought meeting with the accountability partner was a little anxiety-inducing on top of all of the assignments and reading. Is it possible that this class can be presented in 16 weeks, or eliminate some of the elements of the course
- I personally would have loved to have another zoom session in this course just because I loved it. I appreciated the schedule change since we were all working in different areas. You allowed us the freedom to change our projects as we evolved in our own understanding of the content. Thank you!

I really enjoyed doing the analyses assignments however I think it would be helpful to move the journal analysis one week earlier to give more time to work on the project in the final two weeks. I know this would put the journal assignment the week right after the Ed Resource assignment, but I also think more time to focus solely on the project leading up to the deadline would have helped alleviate some of my stress especially if this class runs during the holiday season again.
